Level 3 Pilot 2010, June 21-22 (The Eva 'Skip' Gumbert Aviation Camp)

Aviation camps are conducted by museum staff at the Aviation Museum of Kentucky, Inc., Blue Grass Airport, Lexington, and at other locations throughout Kentucky. Camps at the museum are two days in length from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. daily. Planned activities are listed below. Variations in flights and camp activities may occur due to unforeseen circumstances. **Note to parents:** Students who are 14 or 15 years old are enrolled in the Level 3 camp.

- **Help fly an actual airplane:** With an FAA certified pilot, students will participate in planning and conducting a flight in the central Kentucky area.
- **Tour of airport facilities and related services:** Students may visit other locations at Blue Grass Airport to learn about careers and how the airport works.
- **Museum based activities:** Sessions include *Flight Simulation, Navigation and Aeronautics*. Activities cover flight maps, airplane instruments, aviation history, aviation careers, glider competition, forces of flight, etc. Campers also get a photo of themselves with an airplane.
- **Dates - June 21 and 22; 8:30 until 3:30 daily**

- **Confirmation, registration** or other questions? Call or email as noted above.
- **Eligibility** - Students must be at least 14 years old by the first day of camp.

Note: Ages 10 – 11 may enroll in the Level 1 camp; ages 12–13 may enroll in the Level 2 camp. Call (859) 353-0467 or visit www.aviationky.org for camp applications.

- **Transportation to camp is provided by parents.**
- **Lunch,** snacks and drinks are provided.
- **To enroll,** complete the application below and return it with a check for \$219 per student, payable to the *Aviation Museum of Kentucky, Inc.* If financial aid is **required** in order to attend camp, go to the museum website to obtain the application form.
