Level 1 Pilot 2012, June 14-15 for ages 10 and 11 (The Jerry Landreth Aviation Camp)

Aviation camps are conducted by museum staff at the Aviation Museum of Kentucky, Inc., Blue Grass Airport, Lexington, and at other locations throughout Kentucky. Camps at the museum are two days in length from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. daily. Planned activities are listed below. Variations in flights and camp activities may occur due to unforeseen circumstances.

Camps are named for individuals who have made extraordinary contributions of time and/or financial assistance to the museum. If interested, contact the camps director for 'naming' guidelines.

- **Help fly an actual airplane:** With a FAA certified pilot, students will participate in planning and conducting a flight in the central Kentucky area.

(NOTE: If the flight must be cancelled for any reason such as weather, a refund of \$75.00 will be made to the parent or sponsor who has previously paid the full camp tuition.)

• **Tour of airport facilities and related services:**

Students may visit other locations at Blue Grass Airport to learn about careers and how the airport works.

- **Museum based activities:** Student activities include flight simulation, navigation, aeronautics, airplane instruments, airplane design, weather, air traffic control, careers, etc. Campers also get a photo of themselves with an airplane.

- **Confirmation, registration** or other questions? Call or email as noted above.

- **Eligibility** - Students must be at least 10 years old by the first day of camp.

- **Note:** Ages 12-13 may enroll in the Level 2 camp; ages 14-15 may enroll in the Level 3 camp. Call (859) 3536 0467 or visit www.aviationky.org for camp applications.

- **Transportation** to/from camp is provided by parents.

- **Lunch,** snacks, drinks and camp t-shirt are provided.

- **To enroll,** complete the application below and return it with a check for \$229 per student, payable to the **Aviation Museum of Kentucky, Inc.** If financial aid is **required** in order to attend camp, go to the museum website to obtain the application form.
